Betty Gilmore Woods Greek Achievement Award

The Greek Achievement Award recognizes an outstanding fraternity or sorority alumna/us who exemplifies Greek ideals, has exhibited leadership and given sustained (**at least 3 years**) service to his/her own Greek community in addition to the Western Region Greek Association, Western Region Greek Leadership Conference or the Western Region Volunteer Institute. The nominee must reside in the Western Region.

Each IFC, NPHC, NALFO, MCG, Panhellenic and Joint/All-Greek Council may nominate an alumna or alumnus who is not a paid campus fraternity and/or sorority advisor, for this individual award. Individual campus fraternity/sorority advisors, national organizations and fraternity/sorority staff and volunteers may also make nominations.

Nominations may not exceed 3 (8-1/2 x 11) pages plus cover. It is desirable that the nominee be present to accept the award. If your nominee is selected, you will be notified in advance so that arrangements can be made for him/her to be present for the WRGA closing banquet awards presentation. Members of the current WRGA Board and Conference Committee and previous recipients are not eligible to receive this award.
