



## Outstanding Greek Advisor of the Year

The Outstanding Greek Advisor Award recognizes a paid campus professional who works in the field of fraternity and sorority advising. The nominee is someone who exemplifies Greek ideals, acts as a positive change agent on their campus, fosters high ideals and provides sustained support in the Greek collegiate students of the Western Region. The nominee offers students on their campus and in the Western Region sustained support for the growth and success of the Greek community on their campus, and serves as an educator and role model for collegiate Greek members in the Western Region.

Individuals, councils and campus professionals may nominate someone for Greek Advisor of the Year. The nomination may not exceed 3 8 ½ x 11 pages and must be typed. Please submit your nomination in your awards packet. It is appropriate for the letter to be signed or compiled by more than one person. It is desirable that the nominee be present at the Western Region Greek Leadership Conference to accept the award. If your nominee is selected, you will be notified in advance so that arrangements can be made for him/her to be present for the closing banquet awards presentation. Members of the current WRGA Board and Directors of the Award Committee, and past award recipients are not eligible to receive this award.
